Field and Equipment Information: A gas-powered, continuous
loop machine will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic
bags. The field is mowed grass and basically level. The 300 yard
course will be run for the “small dog” and “flat faced dog” class.
Please refer to “Eligibility and Rules” for details on class eligibility.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
- Dogs must be present before the end of roll call. No refund for absent dogs.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entries will be refunded.
- WHWTCA reserves the right to alter course due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the test.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds by the Test Committee.
- All dogs run at owners' sole risk. The hosting club and property owners, their agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors and handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
- There will be a \$50 returned check charge.
- A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress or for any handler not cleaning up after their dog.

ELIGIBILITY

Coursing Ability Tests are open to all dogs at least 1 year of age by the day of the test that are individually registered with the American Kennel Club, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, and dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not enter. A dog may only enter each test once.

RIBBONS & ROSETTES

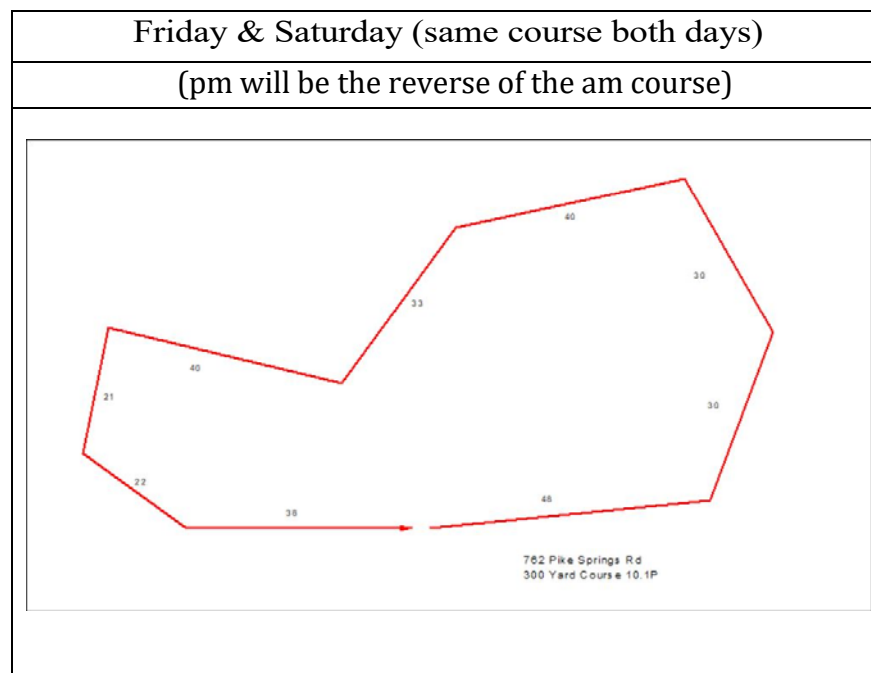
WHWTCA will award an orange flat ribbon to each dog that receives one qualification leg toward a Coursing Ability Title and an orange rosette to each dog that receives a Coursing Ability Title.

PASSING PERFORMANCE

The Coursing Ability Test is a pass-fail event. In order to pass, the dog must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within the maximum amount of time for the course length. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog's performance.

COURSES

(This CAT will only offer 300-yard courses, 200-yard courses for veterans)



TITLES

Titles will be awarded for dogs that pass the Coursing Ability Test the required number of times.

Coursing Ability (CA) – Awarded to a dog that passes the Coursing Ability Test three times under at least two different judges.

Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA) – Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test a total of ten times. (CA+7 additional passes)

Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX) – Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test a total of 25 times. Coursing Ability

Excellent 2 (CAX2) – Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test a total of 50 times. A higher numbered title will be awarded for every additional twenty five passes.

TIPS FOR HANDLERS

1. Dogs may run wearing a close fitting buckle collar. Choke collars and collars with dangling decoration will not be allowed. Hanging collar tags may be permitted if they are secured tight to the collar, such as by tape. Slip leads can be used.
2. Handlers should wear comfortable, sturdy shoes and be physically able to hold and release their dogs, as well as catch them.
3. A dog that relieves itself on the course will fail the test, so potty your dog before your run.
4. Handlers may carry toys or treats on their persons to assist with retrieving their dog at the completion of their run.
5. Dogs will be brought to the start line on leash and released only upon a verbal signal ("Tally-Ho!") from the Huntmaster.
6. Handler will retrieve their dog upon completion of the run and leave the field with the dog on leash.
7. Handlers are advised to warm up their dogs prior to their run and walk them for about 10 minutes afterwards.
8. Coursing Ability is a physically demanding sport so please make sure your dog is in good shape. If you are not sure, make an appointment with a veterinarian to get an opinion.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW

From PA Turnpike – Exit #312 (Downingtown). Go South on Route 100. Turn Left (North) on Route 113 (Uwchlan Road). Follow Route 113 North approximately 7 miles (watch for a flashing yellow light).

(for GPS directions, use 762 Pike Springs Rd, Phoenixville, PA 19460)

HOW TO ENTER

Complete an official AKC entry form for each dog for each test. Entry forms are located at the end of this premium list. Each dog may only enter once per test, a total of twice per day.

Enter early, as only 60 entries will be accepted for each test or a maximum of 120 entries per day. Make checks payable to "WHWTCA". Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

The Event Secretary must have the completed entry form and payment before a dog may be presented for inspection.

INSPECTION

Dogs will be inspected for lameness, fitness to compete and female estrus (in season). Any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season shall not be allowed to enter and the applicable entry fees shall be refunded.

Roll call and inspection will run continuously for the period of time listed. Bring your dog at any time during that period. Any dog that is not present for inspection prior to the close of roll call will be marked absent. No refund will be given for an absent dog.

After your dog has been inspected, your dog will be added to the running order. Dogs will be run in the order of inspection.

If a dog is not present when it is called to run its test, the dog's name will be moved to the end of the running order. After roll call and inspection closes, any entered dog that has not yet tested and is not present within 5 minutes of completion of the last

course will be marked absent and no refund will be given.

RUNNING THE COURSE

Each dog runs by itself and only one time in each test. They chase lures made of plastic strips that, by string and pulleys, following a course in a field.

Any entered dog that is less than 12-inches tall at the withers or brachycephalic (i.e., "flat-faced", such as a bulldog) will run a clearly marked 300-yard course, which must be completed in 90 seconds

If your dog is 7 years of age or older, you may declare your dog a "**veteran**" prior to the start of its course. Your dog will be allowed to run two-thirds of the normal distance.

Six hundred yard courses will not be offered at these tests.
