CERTIFICATION: An **original** Judge's Certification (not a copy) must accompany your TD entry form for this test. FAX, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

CHECKS should be payable to WHWTCA.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. All cancellations must be written and received by the Test Secretary before the closing date.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of errors.

CLOSING DATE FOR THE TRACKING TEST is 6:00 p.m., Thursday, September 22, 2011, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted.

THE CLUB MAY CANCEL the event in the case of extreme weather conditions. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or the grounds and / or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well being of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made.

ENTRIES WILL BE DRAWN AT 510 Baynard Boulevard - Carrcroft, Wilmington DE 19803 at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 22, 2011. Preference will be given to West Highland White Terriers.

DRAW ORDER: The Test Secretary will draw entries randomly with first preference going to West Highland White Terriers without titles for the TD / TDX / VST Tests. When the test class limit has been reached for TD / TDX / VST Tests, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on respective alternate lists, corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. In the event any of the accepted TD / TDX / VST entries cancel or are absent on the day of the test, the Test Secretary will contact the alternates on the appropriate alternate list in the order in which they have been drawn. Alternates may accept or reject to exhibit. Entry fees will be refunded by mail to those alternates who do not participate. Exhibitors will be notified within 24 hours by e-mail or phone or mail regarding the results of the draw.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulation. This section requires notification to the Test Secretary prior to the drawing of tracks. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate only after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

From the North: I-95 or NJ Turnpike South over the Delaware Memorial Bridge. Take Exit 279 (Elkton) to Route 213 North. Follow Route 213 North to Route 273. Turn right (East) on Route 273, go past the racetrack, under a bridge, pass Gallaher Road (on your right) and keep going straight on 273 to the blinking light at Appleton Road. Turn left at Appleton. Drive 1.2 miles. Turn left into the parking lot.

From the South: I-95 North to Exit 100 (North East). Turn left off ramp onto Route 272 North. Follow Route 272 North to Route 273. Turn right (East) on Route 273. Continue straight after the light at Fair Hill (Route 213), go past the racetrack, under a bridge, pass Gallaher Road (on your right) and keep going straight on 273 to the blinking light at Appleton Road. Turn left at Appleton. Drive 1.2 miles. Turn left into the parking lot.

From I-95 Exit 1B (Alternate Directions): Follow Route 896 for 2.4 miles (toward Newark / University of Delaware) (896 becomes South College Avenue). Turn left on West Main St. and take the middle fork Route 273 West (from the light on West Main to Appleton Road is 3.5 miles). Turn right at blinking light at Appleton Road. Go 1.2 miles. Turn left into the parking lot.

8 TD, 5 TDX, 2 VST TESTS: WEST HIGHLAND WHITE TERRIERS PREFERRED

TD, TDX, and VST tracks not filled by West Highland White Terriers will be available to other breeds. Order of selection in each test will be Westies without titles, Westies with titles, then other breeds without titles. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in another test, the number of tracks may be exchanged.

2 TD = 1 TDX or 1 VST 1 TDX = 1 VST

AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to all teams that obtain their titles at these tests.

ABOUT THE SITE

Fair Hill was one of the largest private land holdings in the east, formerly owned by William DuPont, Jr., an avid equestrian who acquired the farmland to enjoy horseback riding and fox chasing. The area still supports equestrian events: steeplechase, timber course and flat races. Foxcatcher Farm Covered Bridge is an historic point of interest. It was constructed in 1860. The site comprises various ecosystems: grasslands, trout streams, ponds, wetlands, and ~3,000 acres of mature woodlands. Habitats support a variety of wildlife such as hawks, owls, an occasional bald eagle, grassland birds, beaver, fox, coyote and white-tailed deer.
