ELIGIBILITY

- Dogs must be six months of age or older and registered with the AKC. Spayed or neutered dogs, dogs with limited registration and dogs with an ILP are eligible to participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate subject to Chapter 11, Section 1 of the Dog Show Rules. The following breeds are classified as eligible to participate in Earthdog tests: Dachshunds and the following Terrier breeds; Australian, Bedlington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Fox (Smooth and Wire), Glen of Imaal, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Miniature Schnauzer, Norfolk, Norwich, Parson Russell, Rat, Russell, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Welsh and West Highland White.
- Inasmuch as Dachshunds and Terriers are hunting dogs, dogs disfigured as the result of accident or injury but otherwise qualified shall be eligible. Dogs that are blind and/or deaf shall not be eligible.
- Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will not be refunded unless the Test Secretary is notified before entries close.
- Master Earthdog is open only to dogs that have acquired the Senior Earthdog title before entries close or awarded the Master Earthdog Title.
- Senior Earthdog is open only to dogs that have acquired the Master or Junior Earthdog title before entries close.
- Junior Earthdog class is open to all eligible breeds of dogs that have not been recorded as or received qualifying scores in Senior Earthdog or Master Earthdog. Except dogs which have earned a Master Earthdog title may enter Junior Earthdog Class.
- Dogs may enter only one regular class at an Earthdog Test; except dogs which have earned a Master Earthdog title may enter more than one regular class. (Regular classes are Junior, Senior or Master).
- Introduction to Quarry is not a pre-requisite for Junior Earthdog; Introduction to Quarry is designed for the novice dog; however, all dogs may enter Introduction to Quarry. **Scheduling is such that running orders cannot be altered for Senior and Master dogs to run Intro before their regular class.**
